• **Club Development**

1. **Clubmark licence**

The Club and Volunteer Development Group are currently working to be a recognised awarding body to award Clubmark to sports with an NGB who don't award Clubmark themselves, i.e. korfbal, ice hockey etc.

2. **Clubmark benefits**

A list of current benefits available to Notts accredited clubs were distributed, along with a suggestion of potential benefits to investigate. If anyone has any further suggestions then please forward.

3. **Local 'accreditation'**

Some districts are currently producing their own 'accreditation' schemes, as a stepping stone to Clubmark. AQ and the CVDG are working to ensure that if these are going to happen that they are co-ordinated and consistent if possible. Just so NGB's are aware if they hear this, but clearly they aren't recognised by anyone outside the area.

4. **Clubs package**

Currently working to produce a pack for clubs in Notts, with all info such as Community Sports Fund (CSF) application, Coach Scholarship Scheme, Intosport info etc. A copy shall be sent to all NGB's, please contact me if more are needed.

5. **Community Sports Fund**

Formerly CIF, the fund is open for applications. The deadlines are 1<sup>st</sup> Dec 08 and 1<sup>st</sup> Feb 09. Criteria are in the pack, main two points when applying, the activity must be new- over and above what the club already offer. The activity must also have not yet started, as retrospective applications cannot be

funded. Please contact for more information on this or any other funding application as we are gathering copies of successful applications to share.

## 6. **Running Sport**

Regional roadshow is next week where we will be investigating how we can train local tutors. If anyone is interested in becoming a Running Sports tutor, please let me know and I shall forward more information as I have it.

### **Plans for 2009**

Have a 'break' from the large single day format in both the inclusive and Saturday events. This will allow breathing space to help re-align sports into existing competition frameworks, help to engage more diverse partners and in some cases re-engage some key organisations.

Crucially this will also allow time to undertake an exercise to determine sports & activities for 2010 onwards and an opportunity to engage with these sports (assessing readiness etc).

In place of the 'traditional' two days of competitions a series of 'county' finals in different sports will be staged. These finals will be selected through a process of identification using knowledge of sports (via the executive & competition managers) and interaction with the sport itself.

NYG 09 will effectively be an umbrella brand under which the programme can accommodate many interests.

It's envisaged that these sports will be existing NYG activities from the 2008 Games i.e. no new sports will be introduced for 2009.

Once a list of possible finals has been collated the executive group will select the most appropriate and issue NYG branding and marketing to that event.  
*Timescales need to be agreed for this action.*

### **Plans for 2010**

- Move back towards a large focused event (*unless 2009 format has proved popular and provided a greater developmental return*).
- Secure new investment into the event.
- Make links with the cultural Olympiad
- Engagement with arts/cultural sector
- Build on competition structures and National Governing Body needs
- Maintains partnership momentum and better division of labour
- Central role for school partnerships
- Local authority in conjunction with NGBs concentrate on club development and progression routes

- County team's contribution to year round event volunteer programme etc
